MAY 20, 2012 - SEVENTH SUNDAY OF EASTER



"Go into all the world and proclaim the good news to the whole creation."

Reflection: Jesus having completed His work on earth, who had come from the Father returns to Him. The Ascension of the Risen Jesus to heaven inaugurates the time of the Spirit and of the Missionary Church. Promising the Spirit, Jesus entrusts to the Apostles the duty of preaching the Gospel and of bearing witness to Him in every part of the world, with the power that the Holy Spirit will communicate to them. God has exalted Christ who experienced the very worst of human misery. God has approved in a visible and resplendent manner the one who was contradicted and despised. And from that time on-wards it is urgent to proclaim the Good News of Jesus to everyone. Then people will be able to remember that one of them has ascended to heaven and is seated at the right hand of God. The mission



requires a departure, a detachment from one's private world, because the Apostles should proclaim the Gospel to the whole creation, to all the nations. The response of this prodamation is faith that is intimately united with Baptism. The believer will possess various gifts and charisma through which Jesus will continue His messianic work. In their work, the Apostles are helped by the Lord Jesus, who shares with them His power and confirms their word with miracles.

CATECHESIS THE FATHER "IN THE NAME OF THE FATHER AND OF THE SON AND OF THE HOLY SPIRIT"

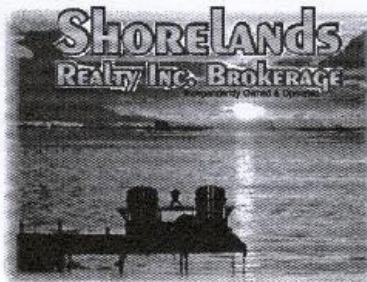
