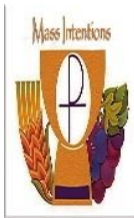

SUNDAY READINGS

First Reading: Genesis 14: 18-20

Psalm 110: You are a priest forever, according to the order of Melchizedek.

Second Reading: Corinthians 11: 23-26

Gospel: Luke 9: 11b-17

REFLECTION

THE GIFT OF THE EUCHARIST

Today we hear how Abram encounters Melchizedek, “king of Salem . . . and a priest of God Most High” (Genesis 14:18). Melchizedek appears nowhere else in scripture, but is nonetheless significant. Psalm 110 declares of the great King David, “You are a priest forever, in the line of Melchizedek,” a description later given (in the letter to the Hebrews) to Christ as High Priest. Early Christians saw in Melchizedek’s bread and wine the bread and wine of the Eucharist; St. Paul’s account of the Last Supper (in today’s

second reading) is the oldest one in scripture. In the Gospel, St. Luke describes Jesus providing bread for a crowd in words similar to St. Paul’s, words still used by the Church: Jesus takes bread, gives thanks, breaks it. Together, these three readings reveal how Christian priesthood, Christ’s Real Presence, and the call to serve those in need are all found in the gift of the Eucharist.

3. **Attend Mass on First Friday’s of the month**

It is spiritually valuable to participate in Mass at any time, but to do so on consecutive First Fridays is a custom associated with devotion to the Sacred Heart.

4. **Place an image of the Sacred Heart in your home, and consecrate your family to the Sacred Heart**

Devotion to the love of the Sacred Heart can strengthen the love at the heart of each family.
